- Must be foaled in Manitoba, have Canadian papers and meet class/purse level criteria

- Out of province breeders are eligible for breeder awards if the horse is sired by a Manitoba stallion registered in the Mb Sires Program in year of conception and foaled in Manitoba
 - To obtain Breeder/Stallion Awards you must be a CTHS member
