Manitoba Incentive Program Purse Supplements 2019:

To qualify for purse supplements:

- Purse supplements are paid out on purse levels to Manitoba-bred 2, 3, 4 and 5 year old horses
- Must be foaled in Manitoba , have Canadian papers and meet class/purse level criteria

- Horse must be bred by a Manitoba resident, be foaled in Manitoba and have Canadian papers.
 - For Classes 1, 2 & 3, horse must be ages 2 thru 5. Older horses 1st –3rd in Class 4 and 5
- Out of province breeders are eligible for breeder awards if the horse is sired by a Manitoba stallion registered in the Mb Sires Program in year of conception and foaled in Manitoba
 - To obtain Breeder/Stallion Awards you must be a CTHS member
